Prerequisites** Preference will be given to Candidates who have completed an FRCPC (Cardiology) Program.

Program Description We are a high volume academic Echo Lab and the 1st to be accredited by the CCN in Ontario. Our imaging research programs are supported by HSF, CFI, SEAMO.

Echo Fellows training in our lab will have the opportunity to become experts in performing and interpreting Transesophageal Echocardiograms, as well as develop skills in 3D Echo, Strain, and CRT Optimization. There are hand held cardiac ultrasound and vascular imaging projects available. Candidates will also be exposed to CT and Nuclear training and have the opportunity to gain experience in Animal Imaging.

This fellowship offers one position over a one year period with either a full time academic stream (\$50,000 /year) or a flexible community stream (\$40,000 / year) that allows trainees to bill and retain any additional locum billings. Both streams have a research requirement, minimal home call obligation (one weeknight per week for TEE only, no TTE call), and have some support available for attending a scientific conference. There are no additional clinical/ward obligations.
